**EASTER MONDAY MASS 10.00am** Bishop Kenney will be coming to St. Osburg's to celebrate Mass with the people and priests of Coventry and district on Easter Monday. This custom originated in Birmingham in the early part of the last century. It is a profession of faith in the real presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. It is wonderful to be gathered as the local church, with a successor of the Apostles, at Easter. As this is "***The Church of the Most Holy Sacrament and Saint Osburg***" it would be most fitting for the whole parish to come together for the Easter Monday Mass. There will be a cup of tea in the Hall afterwards.
