**TODAY, APPEAL BY THE APOSTLES OF JESUS** The Apostles of Jesus is the first indigenous missionary order founded on the African continent. We are fortunate that their first English parish is St. Elizabeth's here in Coventry, served by Fr Moses from Sudan and Fr John from Kenya. Last year the Superior General of the Apostles of Jesus visited our Archbishop. His Grace writes: "Fr Augustine told me of a particular situation in the Sudan where the seminary of the Apostles of Jesus was occupied by Sudan armed forces, over the last 20 years, and partially destroyed. It has recently been handed back to the Congregation. He asked if it would be possible for Fr Moses and Fr John very occasionally to make a parish appeal for help with the restoration of the seminary."
