FAMILY FAST DAY & THE CRISIS IN ZIMBABWE This Friday is Family Fast Day. Please take a CAFOD envelope today to use in the second collection next Sunday for CAFOD. The situation in Zimbabwe is now so critical that CAFOD have decided that all funds they raise from Harvest Fast Day this year will go to people there who urgently need your help. By March one in three people are expected to be without food. CAFOD has a long history of working in the country through trusted partners who have direct access to people in some of the most badly affected areas. Through these partners, CAFOD will be reaching out to 18,000 of the most vulnerable families.
