DIOCESAN LEVY Every parish pays its share of the work of the diocese. Since the beginning the diocese has invested in schools, having to pay a proportion of the building and maintenance costs. The levy for this is 16 ½ % of last year’s offertory collections. We also pay our share of the diocesan overheads, e.g. the curial offices, the salary for youth chaplain, vocations director etc. This is 8 ½% of last year’s offertory collections. This makes 25% of our offertories in 2005, a levy on our parish this year of £11,315. We are asked to pay £2,828.75 each quarter. This shows particularly the sacrifice we continue to make for the Catholic education of our children.
