CHURCHES TOGETHER Charity 2010

Each year, with the local churches, we support some charitable work being done either here in Coventry or abroad. This year, we are supporting a local initiative, Carriers of Hope, which provides material help for refugees and asylum-seekers living in the city. Over the next two months, we will be collecting basic essentials such as soap, toothpaste, shampoo and other toiletries, as well as kitchen cleaner, washing-up liquid, scourers and so on. Boxes will be available for anything you can provide. Everything that is collected will be taken, along with contributions from the other local churches, to Cornerstone Methodist Church, from where it will be distributed on Tuesday, September 7th. PAPAL VISIT – STEWARD PERSON SPECIFICATION

- The applicant should be fit and agile, over 18 and fit enough to undertake the duties required.
- Be prepared to deploy any site connected to the Papal visit for a tour of duty that will be from 8-14hrs in length, and involve long periods of standing with short rest periods.
- Possess good communication and inter personal skills.
- Prepared to work as a team member.
- Use initiative to resolve problem effectively.
- Undertake training prior to the event in the following aspects of stewarding: C29 (prepare for Spectator events), C35 (Deal with accidents and emergencies), C210 (control the entry, movement and exit of people at spectator events), site/venue specific training, any training requested/required by partner agencies.
- Undergo a suitable check to ensure the safety of the Holy Father, the event and the reputation of the Catholic Church of England and Wales.
- Be adaptable, and flexible with the postings that may be received, i.e. safety steward, supervisor, car park steward.
- Declare any pre-existing vocational skills that would be of use to the organising team i.e. SIA badge holder, first aider, health and safety advisor.
- Doctors and nurses are also needed to maintain medical cover onsite.
