Today is the 2000th anniversary of the birth of St Paul the Apostle. Our Holy Father Pope Benedict has declared today as the 1st day of the year of St Paul to run until 29th June 2009. He has granted the gift of special graces for the eternal salvation of the faithful. A Plenary Indulgence may be obtained by those who devoutly make a Pilgrimage to the Basilica of St Paul in Rome. The Holy Father has asked that this gift is shared also by those who may not be able to make this pilgrimage to Rome in the local churches throughout the world. In the Birmingham Diocese you can obtain a Plenary Indulgence as follows:

1. By attending Mass or other Solemn Prayers in honour of St Paul today or on the closing of the year of St Paul on 29th June 2009.
2. In all churches & chapels within the Archdiocese of Birmingham which includes the name of St Paul the Apostle in their dedication by devoutly taking part in some Sacred function or pious exercise in his honour.
3. For the sick & housebound who cannot attend the Liturgy of the church as above when they spiritually join in the Jubilee celebrations offering their prayers & sufferings to God.

The Plenary Indulgence may be received by those who are truly detached & repentant of sins, purified by the sacrament of penance, restored by Holy Communion and pray for the intention of the Holy Father the Pope. The Indulgence may be obtained for the benefit of the faithful themselves and for the deceased as many times as they fulfill the conditions of the decree but only one Indulgence may be received in anyone day. (*A Plenary Indulgence means that the Church supports with her prayers the purification of ourselves from the effects of sin so that we may be completely at one with God*)

In Coventry we will be celebrating the Pauline Year with an Ecumenical Service on Saturday 5th July at 3.00pm led by Fr Moses Pitya Parish Priest of St Elizabeth's and Canon Jim Canning at St. Paul's Church of England Foleshill Road, Coventry.

All Souls Parish has a double dedication which is also to the Precious Blood. On Tuesday 1st July they be celebrating the Solemnity of the Precious Blood with a concelebrated mass at 7 pm. Fr Michael Brandon, their Parish Priest has invited our Parishioners of St Joseph the Worker to join them and has asked Fr Jordan to preach. When we celebrated the Solemnity of St Joseph the worker on 1st May, 30 parishioners of All Souls joined us which doubled the number participating in our celebrations. So don't forget this Tuesday at 7 pm in All Souls for the celebration of the Solemnity of the Precious Blood.
