**THIS SUNDAY - CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION FROM ST OSBURG'S** Our Corpus Christi Procession for the Parishes of Coventry is this Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> June, **beginning at 3pm in St Osburg's Parish Hall.** It will process through the Shopping Precinct, to the Priory Ruins of the Benedictine Cathedral. There we will have prayers for God's blessing on the pastoral visit of Pope Benedict, Benediction, and ending with the Salve Regina to mark the re-instatement of the Statue of Our Lady of Coventry on that site. Please come to the Corpus Christi Procession in this momentous year.

**PAPAL VISIT-INVOLVEMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE** His Grace, the Archbishop has written to us: "I have recently been contacted by those helping to prepare the Papal Visit. They have requested that one young person (aged 16-20) from each parish in the country comes to Central London for the day on Saturday 18 September. They will be part of a group who will listen to the Pope speak briefly to young people, and who will also have a good location in the evening vigil of prayer and praise. This delegation of young people will be under the guidance of the Birmingham Catholic Youth Service and will travel down to London together on one of 5 coaches.

The Birmingham delegation will then travel together to Coventry airport and take part in a specially arranged candlelight vigil and morning prayer with the sunrise on Sunday 19 Sept. This will then be followed by the celebrations prepared by our own Diocese for the Papal visit. The coaches will then transport the young people back to their departure point." *You must be available from 5pm on the Friday evening through to the Sunday evening.
