This week asbestos has been cleared from the cellar of the house where the heating boilers are and the passageways for the pipes underground to the church. Work has begun on removing the vinyl tiles in church and asbestos from the underfloor pipes. The stone flooring in the sanctuary is being removed in preparation for the underfloor heating. Our heat source has not yet been decided. The feasibility (and affordability) of a geothermal heat source is being investigated.
