CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION FOR THE COVENTRY DEANERY Our Corpus Christi Procession for the Parishes of Coventry is on Sunday, 13th June, beginning at 3pm in St Osburg's Parish Hall. It will process for the first time over the New Bridge, through the Shopping Precinct, to the Priory Ruins of the Benedictine Cathedral. There we will have prayers for God's blessing on the pastoral visit of Pope Benedict, Benediction, and ending with the Salve Regina to mark the re-instatement of the Statue of Our Lady of Coventry on that site. Please come to the Corpus Christi Procession in this momentous year.

RESTORATION OF ST OSBURG'S Midland Conservation Ltd, moved on to the site at 6.30am Monday morning with the delivery of their office, toilets, and storage container; and security fencing. A plumber and electrician connected supplies for them. During the week the carpenters have been protecting the features of the church. On Tuesday the organ builders came and removed a number of the big pipes into the loft of the Parish Hall and sheeted the organ to protect it during the work. Sound engineers removed the sound system from the Church and reinstalled it in the parish hall. Unfortunately it was not possible to transfer the "Loop System", but a new one will be installed in the Church. On Tuesday also, volunteers moved a number of the church benches into the parish hall. On Wednesday the temporary altar furnishings were put in place. On Thursday the first Mass was said and further work was done on the benches, and all the choir resources were carried over to the hall. On Friday the Statues of the Sacred Heart, and Our Blessed Lady, were taken down, washed and put in place in the parish hall. On Saturday, after the morning Mass, the first Baptism took place. All in all an eventful and happy week!

We are indebted to those who made possible the move from the church to the parish hall. We especially thank Derek Woodward, supported by Veronica, who made the temporary altar, the tabernacle plinth, altered and covered the stage screen, and put up supporting shelves for the statues. Con McHugh came on Saturday and took some progress pictures. He will continue to do this throughout the project.
