**MEETING ABOUT TESCO'S RE-DEVELOPMENT PLAN
IN ST JOSEPH THE WORKER COMMUNITY HALL
17TH OCTOBER AT 7PM.**

This meeting is mainly for Cannon Park residents but the re-development plan involves siting Tesco's petrol station next to our church.

Councillor Tim Sawdon Cabinet Member (Culture Leisure and Libraries) Wainbody Ward Coucillor has written to a correspondent of Cannon Park Estate as follows :--

May I say from the outset that Tesco did not inform either myself or my fellow Ward Councillors of either the exhibition of their plans or the public meeting. It would also seem that they did not inform either the Council's Planning Department or the University!

After discussion with my colleagues it would appear that the best way forward is to make use of our next Ward Forum which is on Tuesday November 6th (currently booked at Finham Park School at 7pm) to discuss the issue. At that meeting we are hoping to have representatives from Tesco, the University and Planning Department to answer questions. I hope you will be able to be present.

In the meantime we shall be keeping a watchful eye in case Tesco submit their planning application earlier than November 6th and take any necessary action. Clearly we cannot make any official objection until we see their final plans.
